Dear Parents and Caregivers,

We are closing in on the end of another year and there has been so many good things happening around the school. I'd like to remind everyone of the importance of attendance at school and urge everyone to keep coming to school every day for the remainder of the year.

Resilience Speaker

On Wednesday 8th November we had a guest speaker Adam, from "Armed for Life" which aims to raise mental health awareness and build resilience for youth. This program works with the R U OK? Foundation. Adam shared his experiences and stories with students, and what he has done to overcome barriers in life. Students were engaged and are looking to do more work with Adam next year to help build resilience.

Exams

This term the HSC wrapped up, officially completing schooling for all of our Year 12 students. Now we wait excitedly for the results to be released and I'm sure they will be positive for our students. Years 7-10 sat their Yearly Exams in Week 6 and put in a fantastic effort. I'm hopeful the results will reflect the hard work they have put in this year.

Year 12 Farewells

On Thursday 2nd November we formally farewelled our Year 12 students. They had a graduation assembly in the morning where folios were presented, then they all donned their best suits and dresses for the formal dinner in the evening. While we are always sad when students leave us, we are incredibly proud of their achievements, and it is a pleasure to celebrate them. Ag Camp

In Week 5 we had a group of students travel to Moree to participate in an agriculture camp run by the Regional Industry Education Partnership. This camp was targeted at female students and aimed to show all the agriculture jobs available in the area. Students learned about aviation farming, visited fish, cotton, cattle and crop farms. They took a lot out of this camp and now have a strong idea of what is available to them for a career in the agriculture industry.


