Well done to everyone on their efforts on the day and big thank you to the parents that attended, it was very much appreciated.

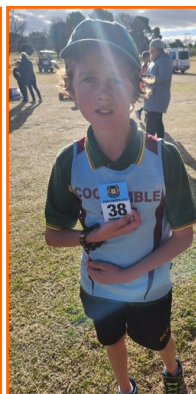

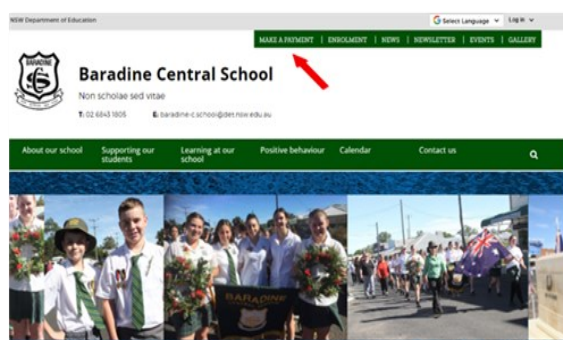
